NOTICE of RACE

Organizing Authority:



SetSail Yachting Club and Setsail Charter is inviting you all to take part in the SetSail Corporate Regatta to be held in Marina Limanu, Romania between 22nd – 24th of June, 2018.

1. RULES

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing
- 1.2. World Sailing Equipment Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 will apply.
- 1.3. World Sailing Offshore Special Regulations appendix b, Special Regulations for Inshore Racing will apply
- 1.4. ORC Rating Rules will apply.
- 1.5. No national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.6. The Official Languages of the Regatta is English and Romanian. If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.
- 1.7. Spinnakers and gennakers will not be used. This is changing the ORC Rating System Rules.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1. The boats might be required and will have to apply stickers with the name of event sponsors, supplied by the organizing authority.
- 2.2. By participating in the Corporate Regatta a competitor automatically grants to the Organising Authorities the perpetuity right to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him/her, taken during the period of competition for the said Corporate Regatta, in which the competitor participates and in all materials related, without compensation.

3. CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

As per request of the event organizers the boats shall facilitate to install video and sound equipment or cameras, provided by the organizers. This installation will not amend the certificates of the boats.

4. ADDITIONAL CREW

As per request of the event organizers the boats shall facilitate to carry one guest additional to their standard crew/guests. This will not amend the certificates of the boats.

5. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 5.1. Entries shall be made only by the Organising Authority. Additional documents listed below should also be provided by the skippers:
 - Crew list filled in;
 - Skipper sailing license;
- 5.2. The Regatta is open to keelboats provided by the organising authority. Boats will be divided considering ORC GPH as per Race Committee decision that shall be final.

6. IDENTIFICATION

Every boat will be required to display the Regatta registration numbers if will be provided by the Organising Authority.

7. SCHEDULE

Friday, the 22nd of June

- 16:00 to 20:00 – Registration. Each team will receive:
 - a contest manual containing the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions
 - branded equipment for the teams which required one
- 20:00 to 21:30: Short introduction in sailing/ Skippers meeting.

Saturday, the 23rd of June

- 10:00: Preparations\ Practical training session
- 12:55: Racing, first warning signal
- 19:00: Dinner & Sailors party

Sunday, the 24th of June

- 10:00: Preparations
- 10:55: Racing, first warning signal

- 16:00-17:00: Prize Giving & Closing Ceremony

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be made available to skippers/sailors at the Regatta Office.

9. VENUE

- 9.1. The Corporate Regatta will be held in Marina Limanu.
- 9.2. The courses will be set in the Black Sea waters close to Mangalia.

10. THE COURSES

- 10.1. The sailing course will be announced in the Sailing Instructions with an enclosed drawing.

11. SCORING

11.1. The scoring system is as follows:

- The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A .
- Inshore race results will be determined by corrected times calculated by Triple-Number method.
- Offshore race results will be determined by corrected times calculated by ToT and will have a 1.2 weight in overall scoring.

11.2. 1 (one) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.3. When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

11.4. When 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst scores, but not excluding the offshore race score.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATION

12.1. Except in an emergency or if requested by the race committee, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

12.2. The official communication channel of the race will be VHF Channel 10.

12.3. VHF Channel 16 is mandatory to be kept open at all times when afloat.

13. Mooring

13.1. Boats may be placed in Marina Limanu

13.2. Boats should not be lifted from the water during the regatta, unless there is a written consent from the race committee.

14. PRIZES

14.1. Cups and medals will be awarded to every boat placing first, second and third in each class and subclass.

14.2. The organising committee might award additional prizes at its discretion.

15. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority and any other party or person involved in the organization of the event will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16. INSURANCE

It is recommended that all participating boats to be insured with valid third-party liability.
